

PAS Science Fair Display Board Requirements

All PAS display boards **MUST** include the following sections with these headings (see PAS display board layout form):

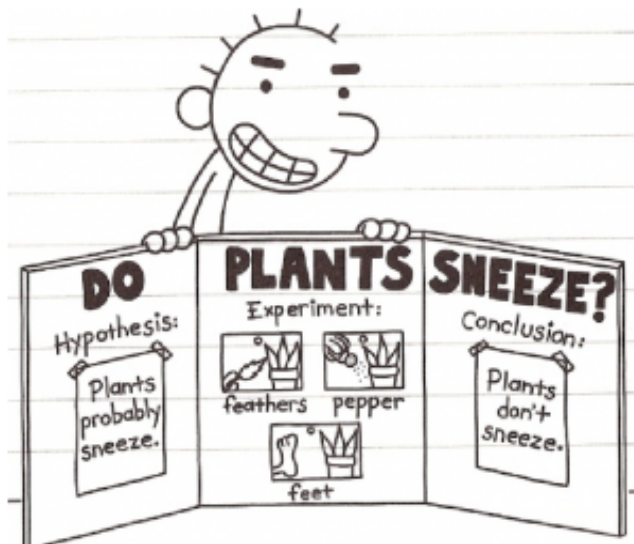
- Title
- Abstract
- Question
- Variables
- Hypothesis
- Materials
- Procedure
- Data
- Results
- Conclusion
- Bibliography

It is not necessary, but students may also choose to add sections such as Background, Future Considerations, Application, ect...

- All science fair boards **must** be typed.
- Your **headings** font should be only **ARIAL** or **TIMES NEW ROMAN** (size **48**).
- The **remaining text** should be the **same font as your headings (size 16-32)** depending on the amount of text you add (“size it” to fit)
- Use **BLACK INK** for the remaining text. **BLACK INK** or another appropriate color for your headings font.
- Write your full name and room number on the **BACK** of the board.

Helpful hints/suggestions for your display board

- Use colored construction paper as backing to provide some color.
- Arrange everything BEFORE you glue.
- Use rubber cement or a glue stick, not the white Elmer's glue.
- Do not use glitter glue or other distracting items.
- Check and double check for spelling errors-have an adult proofread your work.
- Do not write directly on the board.
- Be precise-cut straight (use a paper cutter, when possible) and glue straight.
- Pictures of your experiment really improve the quality of the display board. Be sure to write captions under the pictures to explain what they are showing and/or where you got it.
- Submit your science fair journal, but do not try to attach it to the display board.
- Do not include any pictures of yourself on the board.
